

THE GOOD FRIDAY WALK OF WITNESS

- Lord, please bless all who come and go through this door.
- Protect us when we leave and may we find your welcome on our return.
- We look forward to the time when we can welcome others into our home again.

IN THE LIVING ROOM

- Please bless all who share this room.
- May this be a place of harmony and laughter and relaxation.
- Bless how we connect with one another - whether face to face, on the phone or through the internet.
- May there be peace here in times of solitude.

WHERE WE WORK

- Please bless the work that we do in this place.
- Please bless our creativity, our study and our play.
- May whatever we do bring blessing to others, fulfilment to ourselves and honour to you.

IN THE KITCHEN

- Thank you for your provision.
- Help us to trust you for our needs and to respect the needs of others.
- Please bless the hands that prepare our meals. May they be prepared with love and received with thanks.

WHERE WE EAT

- Thank you that you welcome us to your table.
- May we welcome you at ours
- May you satisfy our deepest hunger.
- Help us to be generous to those around us both inside and outside our home.

WHERE WE SLEEP

- Thank you for our shelter.
- Please grant us deep rest as we sleep.
- Please be present in our dreams
- May we awake with eagerness.

WHERE ANY CHILDREN SLEEP

- Thank you that Jesus said: 'Let the little children come to me'
- Please keep our children in your love, protect them from danger and bring them safely into each new day.

IN THE BATHROOM

- You have told us that if we confess our sins, you forgive us and cleanse us from everything we've done wrong.
- Today of all days we remember that you made this possible by dying on the cross.
- So we say sorry for the wrong things we have done.
- We receive your forgiveness.
- Thank you for washing us clean.
