1. Opening Prayer

Paul Williams opened in prayer.

2. Apologies

Apologies were received from Alderholt Chapel who have decided to withdraw from Churches Together in Fordingbridge & District. Apologies were also received from Pat Bloomfield (chair of The Chosen sub-committee).

3. Report on recent years

The Chair summarised the 2021 – 2024 events (appendix 1) adding that during this time both Fordingbridge Methodist Church and Frogham Congregational Church have closed, and Fordingbridge United Reformed Church will close in the New Year.

4. Finance update

The Statement of Account 1st Aug 2020 to 31st Aug 2024 (appendix 2) was circulated. The Chair reported that donations from the 2022 Easter Play went to the Ukraine Appeal. All other income and expenditure over the past four years related to the screening of the film series The Chosen at Fordingbridge Town Hall and insurance costs. The balance on 30th Sept 2024 was £1,548.38, with £629.83 being the Holiday @ Home balance and the remainder allocated to costs associated with showing The Chosen series 2 in 2025. There are no regular CTIFD contributions from member churches currently.

7. Discussion

Closure of Fordingbridge United Reformed Church

Mike Shrubsole (URC Minister) spoke of the Fordingbridge URC's decision to close, reporting that Sunday morning worship will continue on the 1st and 3rd Sunday each month until the Carol Service on 15th December 2024. This would the last normal Sunday act of worship. **A celebratory thanksgiving service will be held at 3pm on Sunday 19th January 2025** to bring the life of the church to a close (the same day as the Service of Christian Unity in the morning). All building hirers and user groups have been given notice to quit by 31st December 2024. David Williams thought it a tragedy for the URC to close for Christian worship and said his prayer is that somehow a new vibrant Christian presence could be born here, noting the church's strategic position in the town. Paul Williams (NLCC Pastor) has written to the Wessex Synod with a view to leasing the building but has not yet received a response.

Fordingbridge Foodbank

David Williams (Foodbank Manager) reported that the foodbank has been operating from the URC building three times a week since 2015 and supports many people. Ringwood Foodbank pays for an advisor from Citizens Advice to attend on Wednesdays and Fridays to further support their clients. The foodbank is urgently looking for new premises in Fordingbridge but finding it difficult to find somewhere with storage space.

Tim Edwards asked what it would take for the URC closure decision to be reversed. Mike Shrubsole replied that the church needs a secretary and treasurer in order to continue but has neither.

Tim Edwards thought that communication between and from the churches could be improved. He noted that three different churches run pre-school age children's groups on Friday mornings. Mike French (Salvation Army Minister) responded that the timing is often due to the availability of venues and people and all three Friday morning children's groups are well attended. The meeting discussed advertising this year's Christmas Services in The Ringwood and Fordingbridge News. Julian Sims suggested Avon Valley Churches pay for an advert and invoice other CTIFD churches for their share. - The Salvation Army Fordingbridge launch their Christmas present appeal later this month and asked for support from the churches.
- The Branch (run by NLCC) is moving from a retail space into a Café Space this Autumn and is looking to recruit a part time Branch Café Manager. They will also be open an extra day in the week (Thursdays) and working alongside a well-established Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) team in the area, so that their team of volunteers can signpost individuals and families to support they need.
