



**Churches opening after the lock-down:**

**THE CATHEDRAL:** We are pleased to announce that the Cathedral will be open for private prayer from today 10 am to 4 pm. Thereafter we will be open Tuesdays to Saturdays 10 am to 4 pm. Full details <https://stedscathedral.org/re-opening-for-private-prayer>

The new times are 9 am Eucharist (Monday to Saturday) and 5 pm Evening Prayer (Monday to Friday). On Sundays the services are at 10 am and 3.30 pm.

**ALL SAINTS, BURY** are opening 4 to 6 pm Wednesdays and 2 to 4 pm Sundays. These times were picked to allow 72 hours to elapse between each session so that a deep clean is not needed every time. We have a one way system, in through the fire door on one side and out through the other fire door. This is partly because the pre-school are back in the hall and we are therefore not using the entrance area, neither are they, so all are quite separate. We have notices re distancing, using sanitiser etc and most chairs blocked off. The area for prayer is near the altar with pairs of chairs set at 2m distance. We have two people there to make sure all is well. They sanitise all door handles and anything else that they feel they should at the end.

At the moment all churches or chapels will remain closed. We are not normally a church which is open for individual prayer. We are considered a community worshipping church. Prayer is an important aspect here at Trinity and during this difficult time, The prayer group, house groups, pastoral meetings, coffee and chat, Sunday worship and personal contact are paramount at this time.
